Employment Opportunities

Max Lax Lacrosse, Inc. is a lacrosse service organization for children and young adults.

Created and incorporated in September, 1997, by Chick Chakrian, Max Lax Lacrosse started servicing the Long Island lacrosse community in the Spring of 1998 with our user friendly, instructional and fun clinics and camps.

Voluntary and employment opportunities are available for individuals who are male or female lacrosse players, who are currently playing in high school or college, or are college graduates, experienced adult scholastic and college coaches. Teachers licensed in Physical Education with strong lacrosse backgrounds are encouraged to join our Max Lax Team. The following employment categories are available:

- *Community service volunteer*
- *High school, junior counselor(JC), generally qualified freshmen and sophomores*
- *High school, counselor, generally qualified juniors and seniors*
- *High school, qualified graduates*
- *College players, qualified freshmen through seniors, especially Phys. Ed. Majors*
- *Qualified College graduates*
- *Professionals, Certified and qualified teachers and coaches and other adult professionals committed to the youth of Long Island and the lacrosse community.*

Yearly schedule of events:

Generally, the following weeks are scheduled as “camp weeks”:

- *President’s week in February*
- *Spring break (Easter/Passover break)*
- *4 weeks at the beginning of the Summer, starting in early July and ending in early August.*

Camps usually run from 9am to 3pm daily. Coaches generally should be at the site from 8:30am to 3:30pm for early work with the campers and clean up and staff meeting at the end of the day.

Part-time schedules can be accommodated, especially for college student-athletes during President’s Week and Spring Break Camps.

Clinics and Positional camps at various times during the year, depending on availability of facility space.

What am I looking for in a prospective employee or volunteer?

Candidates that are mature, responsible, knowledgeable, talented, dedicated and loyal that genuinely love working with children are encouraged to apply. Candidates must be able to work with their colleagues in a cooperative, professional manner and be responsible for the welfare of the campers in their respective charge. Successful coaches are always in the running for the coveted “Coach of the Week”, the campers favorite coach of the week, or “Dog of the Week”, the camper’s most hated coach of the week. The question that I ask of my coaches and myself is, “Would you want your own child to have that individual as their coach?”

Income potential, re: salary and bonuses:

*The base salary scale at Max Lax Lacrosse is progressive, meaning longevity and loyalty from the start of your employment and each yearly employment anniversary will enhance your salary with a raise. Bonuses are sometimes given out for an exceptional job, well done. **Additionally, coaches and counselors are encouraged to distribute Max Lax Lacrosse Flyers to youth teams, at your neighborhood elementary and middle schools, at Shopping Malls, Parking Lots, College Games and MLL and NLL lacrosse games, etc. By “tagging” the front bottom right hand corner of the flyer with your initials and jersey number you will receive “Finder’s Fee” bonuses for each camper that attends a Max Lax Lacrosse Camp. Please make sure you identify your tag on the data sheet below.*
